

SUBJECT: Update on Public School Academies

At the August 10 meeting of the State Board, a report was presented summarizing the achievement status of public school academies (PSAs) in operation in the 2003-04 school year, and indicating the AYP phase of each academy listed. This report had been requested by the State Board at its meeting on July 7, 2004.

It was learned afterward that the Department of Education had made an error in reporting teacher certification data for the public school academies authorized by Bay Mills Community College (p. 11). This error affected the teacher certification data arranged on the following page (p. 12) by authorizing institution.

Both Greg Olszta, Public School Academy Liaison, and I called Pat Shannon from Bay Mills to apologize for this error. As stated to Mr. Shannon, our jobs in public education are difficult enough without inadvertent errors making it more difficult. As the media also reported on this, they were contacted and made corrections.

The errors in our report were corrected on August 17 and the attached report has been reprinted to include the corrected data. The Department of Education regrets and apologizes for the error.



Phase Report Based on 2003-04 MEAP Data**








2003-04 Transition Results for Public School Academies (PSAs) That Were Identified for Improvement Based on 2002-03 MEAP Data





Original Percentage of All Non Certified Teachers by Authorizer







MDE/Public School Academy/Authorizer Collaborative Efforts 2003-2004

- ❑ July 2003 - MDE provided financial support for *Leading the Business of Charter Schools* held July 15, 2003 through July 17, 2003, implemented by the National Charter Schools Institute. MDE financial support provided full conference scholarships, including accommodations, for 40 PSA school leaders, teachers and board members.
- ❑ 2003 and 2004 Representatives of Michigan Council of Charter School Authorizers (MCCSA), Michigan Association of Charter School Authorizers (MAPSA), Michigan Association of Charter School Boards (MACSB), and MDE meet monthly at the MCCSA Roundtable to share information, discuss issues, and share concerns.
- ❑ 2003 and 2004 MAPSA, MCCSA and MDE staff have continuing dialogue and discussion on how children with disabilities may be better served by PSAs and improvement of relations between ISDs and charter schools.
- ❑ November 2003 Tom Watkins and MDE staff participated in the MAPSA statewide charter school conference attended by more than 1000 persons. MDE staff served as presenters, discussants and speakers at the conference, sharing information, ideas and perspectives.
- ❑ January 2004 State Board of Education Member Elizabeth Bauer and representatives of MAPSA, Authorizers, an educational management organization, and MDE attended the *2nd National Summit* on charter schools serving students with disabilities. Dialogue has resulted in several collaborative proposals to better serve Michigan's children.
- ❑ February 2004 MAPSA, MCCSA Authorizers and MDE staff collaborated on development and submission of the Charter School Program grant application to the USDOE, resulting in the successful \$21.0 million grant award to assist new charter schools over the next three years.
- ❑ April 2004 MDE provided financial support to conduct a daylong Teacher Recruitment Fair, implemented by MAPSA and attracting more than 250 teachers. More than 30 public school academies or educational management organizations were represented to recruit applicants.
- ❑ April 2004 MDE provided financial support to MAPSA to develop a video tape and written informational materials for use as recruitment tools in MAPSA's ongoing effort to work with the 32 schools of education across Michigan to assist in attracting high quality teachers to charter schools.
- ❑ May 2004 MDE sponsored a one day *Symposium: Creating Excellence in the Classroom—Working Together, Charter and Traditional Public Schools* attended by more than 100 educators from charter and traditional public schools to discuss common ground, differences, and how to work together on behalf of Michigan's children. Future similar sessions are planned.
- ❑ July-October 2004 MDE continues financial scholarship support of four (4) days of training for 33 charter school leaders to enhance leadership performance and business practice by participation in *Leading the Business of Charter Schools*, conducted by the National Charter Schools Institute.
