SUBJECT: Creation of a Credit Union Division Public Website

The Office of Financial and Insurance Services has created a public Credit Union Division website to centralize links specifically relevant to the Michigan chartered credit union industry and its consumers. The site will contain links to rules, regulations, bulletins, letters, forms, hearings and consumer information specific to Michigan chartered credit unions. It will also contain links to associated trade/professional organizations and counterpart regulatory agencies.

While the site is meant to be a central access point for information relevant to the regulation of credit unions in Michigan, it will also allow access to other Michigan regulatory websites which may impact a specific credit union through access to the Department of Labor and Economic Growth central portal. This information includes Michigan regulatory sites on insurance, mortgage, securities and other relevant sites.
