

**MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
FISCAL YEAR 2007 LICENSING TIMELINESS STATUS REPORT**

PURPOSE: In fiscal year 2004, the Legislature enacted numerous laws that specify timeframes in which the department is to issue initial and renewal licenses. In addition to timelines, the laws identify penalties that the department will incur if the timelines are not met. The laws also require the department to provide an annual report recapping the timeliness of licenses.
