

Use of Decimals in Final Project Quantities

Most pay items require quantities to be rounded to the nearest whole number. Exceptions to this usually involve very large pay units. The easiest way to do this is to adjust the quantity on one plan sheet so as to make the total for the project a whole number. The list below includes those exceptions (pay items) that allow decimals. Two decimal places are allowed.
