

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The County of Gogebic will receive sealed bids for the Gogebic-Iron County Airport **TERMINAL APRON REHABILITATION** project at the **Mead & Hunt Office, Lansing, Michigan until 2:00 EDT, Friday, April 29, 2016**. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 pm EDT on April 29, 2016, at the Mead & Hunt Office, 2605 Port Lansing Road, Lansing Michigan, 48906.

All bidders must be MDOT prequalified. The net classification required for this project is 571 Ea. In addition to the above minimum prequalification requirement for prime contractors, this project includes sub-classifications of Cb and N93E. If the prime contractor is not prequalified in these sub-classifications, prequalified subcontractors must be used. These subcontractors must be designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.

General shall be required to self-perform a minimum of 25% of the work.

There is a zero (0) percent DBE requirement for this project.

Bids shall be addressed to **Jared Kowalewsky, Mead & Hunt, 2605 Port Lansing Road, Lansing, Michigan 48906**. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. The envelope shall also be marked with the following: **TERMINAL APRON REHABILITATION, Gogebic-Iron County Airport**. Bids must be submitted on the bid forms provided in the proposal.

Bidders shall submit a proposal guaranty in the form of a proposal bond in the amount of not less than five (5) percent of the bid sum. The proposal guaranty shall be made payable to Gogebic County, Ironwood, Michigan. If the selected contractor fails to provide the required materials and/or execute the contract within fifteen (15) days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms, the proposal guaranty will be forfeited to the Sponsor in accordance with Section 30-08 of the General Provisions. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory 100 percent performance bond as well as labor and material bond.

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of ninety (90) calendar days.

The County of Gogebic reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bids or bid, should it consider same to be in its best interest.

This project is being funded in part with Federal Aviation Administration and Michigan Department of Transportation funding. All bidders are required to sign a certification that they will comply with all Federal and State non-discrimination laws and regulations. Work under this project is subject to the most recent Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determination. All state and federal guidelines must be followed.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 20, 2016, at 10:00 am (local time), at the Gogebic-Iron County Airport, FBO/Manager's Building, E 5560 Airport Road, Ironwood, Michigan, 49938. Potential bidders are required to attend the pre-bid meeting.

Scope of Work

This project consists of rehabilitating the asphalt pavement of the apron serving the commercial terminal building, along with some runway surface maintenance. The project shall be complete and ready for final inspection within 61 calendar days from the effective date of Notice-to-Proceed.
