Work shall include the procurement of an airport carrier vehicle (tractor), rotary snow blower, loader bucket, and rotary sweeper and components necessary in accordance with the specifications.

The proposed procurement is included in a capital improvement program project undertaken by the Sponsor in accordance with terms and conditions of agreements between the Sponsor and the Federal Aviation Administration. The bidder shall comply with all applicable equal employment opportunity laws and regulations and other labor requirements as detailed therein. Minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this solicitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, age or national origin in consideration for an award. The bidder shall comply with all regulatory requirements for federally assisted contracts, including the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code, Contract Work Hours, Safety Standard Act, Copeland Regulations, Department of Transportation Regulations and Clean Air and Water Pollution Control Requirements. The **WEST BRANCH COMMUNITY AIRPORT BOARD** reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids. The procurement is funded by federal, state and local agencies. Uncertainty regarding availability of federal funding may delay or preclude award of this contract.
