But first let's talk about school safety. OK2SAY is Michigan's school safety initiative. OK2SAY is a 24/7, 365 early warning system designed to stop violence in schools before it occurs. Now OK2SAY accepts safety tips by email, phone or an app all in a confidential and secure manner.

Now Michigan CSI addresses safe and responsible use of all forms of technology including smart phones, computers, tablets and other devices. By paying attention to what's going on all around you and discussing dangerous or threatening behavior with a teacher, parent or other trusted adult you can save a life. Now your voice is important.

What you do is important. You're important and I'd encourage you to consider the powerful difference your voice can make and to speak up for yourself and help those who can't or won't speak up for themselves.
