Per your request for additional information for questions to your hired investigators, we make the following suggestions:

1. What are the financial projections for the DMC over the next 10 years if it were to remain non-profit? How would the acquisition by Vanguard change these projections? What assumptions are included in the analysis?
2. The acquisition of DMC by Vanquard will have an impact on the larger Detroit community. What do you project as the impact on jobs over the 5 and 10 years?
3. It is normally assumed that a for profit entity will focus on development of high margin services and on decreasing low margin services, How do you see the mix of services provided by the DMC changing as a result of this acquisition? What commitments will be made, that are not confined by the number of years, to provide services that are essential to the needs of Detroit. Specifically we are especially concerned about the future of Receiving Hospital, the neo-natal unit and the level one trauma center.
