The meeting will begin at its scheduled time, but members of the public may access the meeting at the above phone number 15 minutes before it begins. All quorum rules still apply. In the event of a disconnection caused by the meeting host, the Commission will be considered to be in recess. If the host is unable to do so within a period of 30 minutes from the time of the disconnection, the Commission will adjourn and not address any new business until its next meeting. Any decisions made prior to the disconnection will be binding. The Commission will not recess or adjourn due to technical or other issues experienced by individual members of the public that render them unable to attend or participate in the meeting.
