2. A.M. Cleaning has not complied with this subpoena and has not provided any

documents to the Attorney General.

Court issue an order compelling A.M. Cleaning's compliance with the civil

investigative subpoena. Further, this Court should require A.M. Cleaning to pay a

\$1,000.00 civil fine to the Attorney General, as anticipated by MCL 445.908,

because it has failed to comply with the subpoena.
