## PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY GENERAL'S EX PARTE PETITION FOR CIVIL INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS

At a session of said Court, held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2015, in the City of Detroit, Michigan.

On March 17, 2015, this Court reviewed the Attorney General's *Ex Parte*Petition for Civil Investigative Subpoenas (Petition) in the above-captioned matter.

This Court has been advised that this Petition was filed with the Clerk's office today. Eleven proposed subpoenas were presented for in camera inspection along with the Petition.

This Court has reviewed these materials, and finds that probable cause exists to believe the named Respondents have violated one or more provisions of the Michigan Consumer Protection Act, MCL 445.901 *et seq*. This Court further finds that, based on this probable cause, the Attorney General is authorized to proceed with issuing the proposed subpoenas pursuant to MCL 445.907.

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted, and a representative of the Attorney General may proceed to authorize and issue the investigative subpoenas that have been presented to this Court, to the Respondents and to Capital Sales, Co. of Hazel Park, City Petroleum of Dearborn, Tradewell Grocery Distribution in Oak Park, D&B Grocers in Livonia, Trepco Inc. in Madison Heights, Motor Oil Distributors, Inc. in Dearborn, the H.T. Hackney Company in Wyoming, Chase Cash & Carry in Dearborn, and Universal Wholesale in Southfield, Michigan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Attorney General will file with the Clerk copies of all eleven subpoenas once they have been served.
