### **OVERVIEW**

On June 28, 2012, for-profit Duke Lifepoint signed an Asset Purchase Agreement with nonprofit Marquette Hospital, whereby Duke Lifepoint agreed to purchase Marquette Hospital. The Asset Purchase Agreement may be viewed at [www.michigan.gov/mgh](http://www.michigan.gov/mgh) . Because the Attorney General protects charitable assets under Michigan law, Marquette Hospital and Duke Lifepoint have made the Attorney General's review a condition of the sale.

This community forum will: 1) provide the public with an overview of the proposed sale; 2) outline the Attorney General's review process; and most importantly, 3) provide the public an opportunity to comment and ask questions. Representatives of Marquette Hospital and Duke Lifepoint will attend to listen and respond to public comments.
