OVERVIEW

On November 20, 2014, for-profit Prime Healthcare Services agreed to purchase nonprofit St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, a subsidiary of Trinity Health. The Asset Purchase Agreement and other transaction documents may be viewed at www.mi.gov/stjosephmercy. Because the Attorney General protects charitable assets under Michigan law, Trinity Health and Prime have made the Attorney General's review a condition of the sale.

This community forum will: 1) provide the public with an overview of the proposed sale; 2) outline the Attorney General's review process; and most importantly, 3) provide the public an opportunity to comment and submit questions. Representatives of Trinity Health and Prime will attend to listen and respond to public comments.
