This program is in its sixth year and is funded at \$150,000. The funds provide for the administration of the program which matches dentists who are willing to donate services to persons in specific target groups (identified below) needing extensive dental care. The department contracts with the Michigan Dental Association which subcontracts with the National Foundation of Dentistry for the Handicapped located in Denver, Colorado. The funding to the National Foundation supports employee costs to administer and operate the program, some lab fees and recognition plaques for the dentists.

The populations for whom dental services are provided are the following:

- C Persons who are physically and/or mentally impaired
- C Persons with sensory impairments
- C Persons who are medically comprised
- C Elderly persons
