You may leave the list at any time by sending a "SIGNOFF BROADBAND" command to LISTSERV@LISTSERV.MICHIGAN.GOV. You can also tell [LISTSERV](mailto:LISTSERV@LISTSERV.MICHIGAN.GOV) how you want it to confirm the receipt of messages you send to the list. If you do not trust the system, send a "SET BROADBAND REPRO" command and [LISTSERV](mailto:LISTSERV@LISTSERV.MICHIGAN.GOV) will send you a copy of your own messages, so that you can see that the message was distributed and did not get damaged on the way. After a while you may find that this is getting annoying, especially if your mail program does not tell you that the message is from you when it informs you that new mail has arrived from BROADBAND. If you send a "SET BROADBAND ACK NOREPRO" command, [LISTSERV](mailto:LISTSERV@LISTSERV.MICHIGAN.GOV) will mail you a short acknowledgement instead, which will look different in your mailbox directory. With most mail programs you will know immediately that this is an acknowledgement you can read later. Finally, you can turn off acknowledgements completely with "SET BROADBAND NOACK NOREPRO".
