### School Index--*What's New with 2018-19 Results?*

- PSAT 8/9 for grade 8 students has been included in the School Index calculations.
- The Sending Scores Back Program for Shared Educational Entities has been incorporated into School Index calculations.
- School identifications for Support and Improvement:
  - Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI)—no new identifications
  - Additional Targeted Support (ATS)—no new identifications
  - Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)—new identifications using 2018-18 School Index results

### MI School Data Public Releases (2018-19 School Year Data Files)

#### Recently Released

- [Financial Information Reports](#) – includes final expenditure, revenue, fund balance and balance sheet data for districts and at a statewide level.
- [District Financial Transparency Dashboard](#) - provides users with a comprehensive view of district finances, including up to five-year trend information.

#### Coming Soon

- [Parent Dashboard](#) – English Learner Participation, Enrolling and Passing Coursework, and Post-secondary Enrollment metrics will be updated with 2018-19 data.

- [College Enrollment by High School](#) - shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university. The “Time to enrollment” menu option will soon be updated with Fall 2019 data.
- [College Enrollment Destination](#) - this report shows the colleges and universities in which public high school students enrolled by school or district, and by graduation year. The “Enrollment within” menu option will also include Fall 2019 data.
- [Early Childhood Absenteeism](#) - shows attendance rates of K-3 students who participated in early childhood programs before entering kindergarten, such as GSRP, GSRP/Head Start Blend, Head Start, Early Head Start, Early Childhood Special Education or Early On®. This report will be updated with 2018-19 data.
