School Grades Report (formerly A-F)


- Public access released on March 31, 2020 including Report Cards.

MI School Data and MILogin Migration

MI School Data Redesign is moving to MILogin Third Party account by July 2020.

What are the next steps for existing users?

- To retain current secure login status users need to create MILogin Third Party account. MILogin Third Party Website: https://milogintp.michigan.gov/eai/tplogin/authenticate?URL=/
- 2. Use the same email address/credentials as current MI School Data account. Suggestion is to complete by June 1, 2020.
- 3. Security rights should transfer if the account is created before the migration date on July 1, 2020.



CEPI has created a MILogin User Guide to assist secure users with processes, communication steps, and FAQs.

MI School Data Public Releases

Updated in Preview

- <u>24 College Credits</u> shows the amount of time Michigan public high school graduates take to accumulate 24 college credits. (2018-19 data)
- <u>College Remedial Coursework</u> report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling in a Michigan college or university the year after high school graduation. (2018-19 data)
- <u>College Transfers</u> shows transfer patterns, demographics and performance data for students who transferred into or out of a Michigan college or university. (2018-19 data)
- <u>College Undergraduate Enrollment</u> report offers a closer look at the undergraduate classes of Michigan's colleges and universities, including the number of degree-seeking students, student age, and whether students graduated from a Michigan public high school the year prior to enrollment. (2018-19 data)
- <u>Kindergarten Count</u> shows the publicly funded early childhood education programs in which students were enrolled before entering kindergarten, such as *Early On*®, Early Childhood Special Education, Great Start Readiness Program, Head Start and GSRP/Head Start Blend. (2019-20 data)

Coming Soon

- <u>Parent Dashboard</u> metrics related to <u>Postsecondary Completion</u>, <u>Postsecondary Persistence</u> (2018-19 data), <u>and Ratio of Students to Instructional Staff</u> (2019-20 data) will be updated soon.
- <u>Student Pathways</u> this report provides secondary CTE program enrollment history only for the students who have enrolled in a college or university as of the 2009-10 school year. (2018-19 data)
- Non-Resident Status school of choice and other resident statuses for traditional and charter districts. (2019-20 data)
- <u>Retained in Grade</u> shows counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years. (Fall 2019-20 data)
