How are you using the redesigned MI School Data?

According to Miller and Anthony, "MI School Data is being used both as a standalone resource and within MICIP as part of the Data Discovery process. The new design's Education Focus Areas and Dashboards have made accessing multiple types of data much easier and more user friendly. The **Parent Dashboard**, **K12 Landing Page**, **Schools At A Glance**, and the **School Index** are some examples of areas with valuable inquiries that support both districts and the public with critical information. The website's **Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Dashboard** is being used to share publicly what districts statewide are doing regarding face-to-face and remote instruction during this pandemic year. The site is now the "go-to" location for educators, legislators, and the public for state level data."

What is the value of Professional Development in your region?

Professional learning in the region has been "job-embedded" throughout the year as trainers in the region have been provided with information to assist them with supporting their districts. These supports included communications regarding moving to the MILogin Third Party, sharing the statewide MI School Data Webinar Series opportunity, and sending out emails with updates. Regional trainers have also been surveyed at times to find out what activities are

taking place and what supports the regional trainers need. Resources regarding the use of MI School Data within the MICIP platform have been created and shared as well.

What has your role been on the Regional Advisory?

Carol and Kathy have been involved in the TtT Network and Big 10 Committees. Both have created new materials and conducted course development. Kathy has been involved with MI School Data since it evolved from Data for Student Success. She has also been active on the project's ISD advisory committee and has presented on behalf of MI School Data at numerous state level conferences. Carol joined the region two years ago. Throughout the years both have sponsored regional symposiums and provided support to the region's MI School Data trainers.

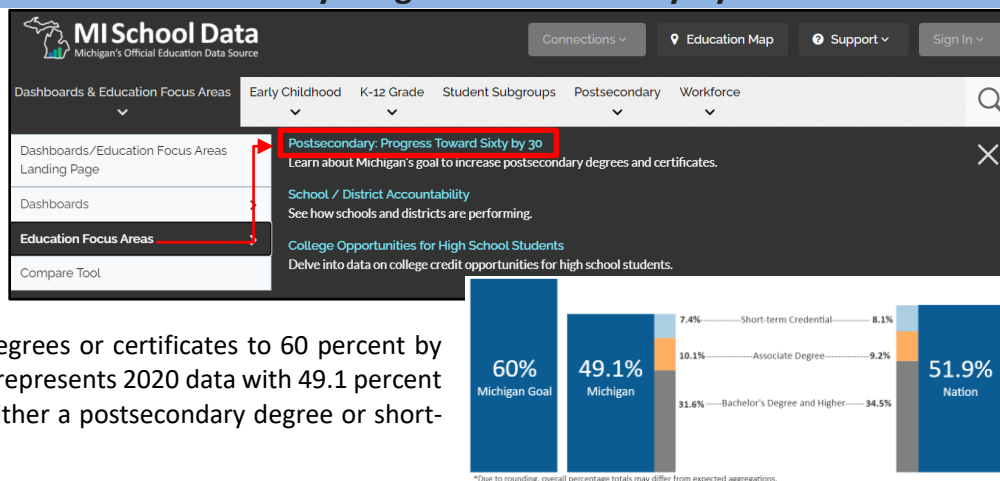

New Education Focus Area - Postsecondary Progress Toward Sixty by 30

The MI School Data team at CEPI has added a new Education Focus Area to the portal/website. What is the [Postsecondary Progress Toward Sixty by 30](#)? In 2019, Governor Whitmer set a goal to increase the percentage of Michigan adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60 percent by 2030. The graph to the right represents 2020 data with 49.1 percent of Michigan adults holding either a postsecondary degree or short-term credential.

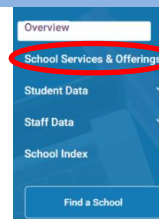


MI School Data News and Updates
