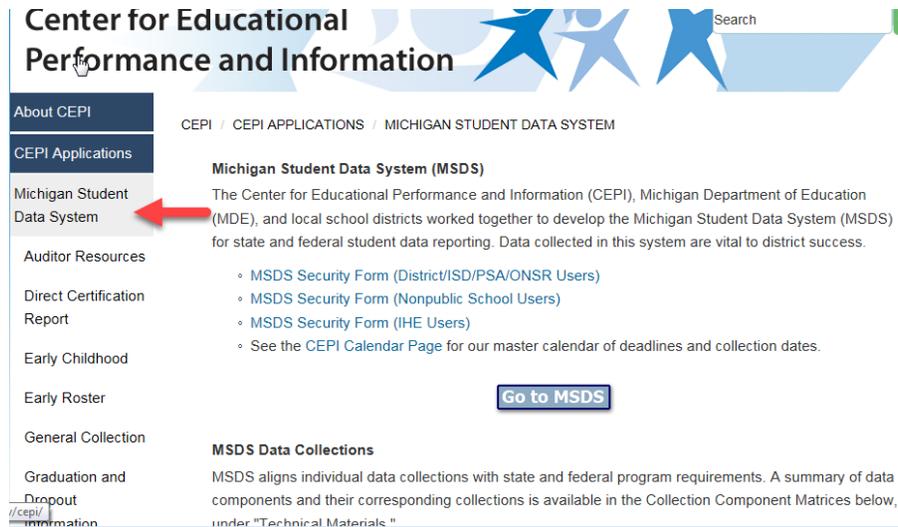


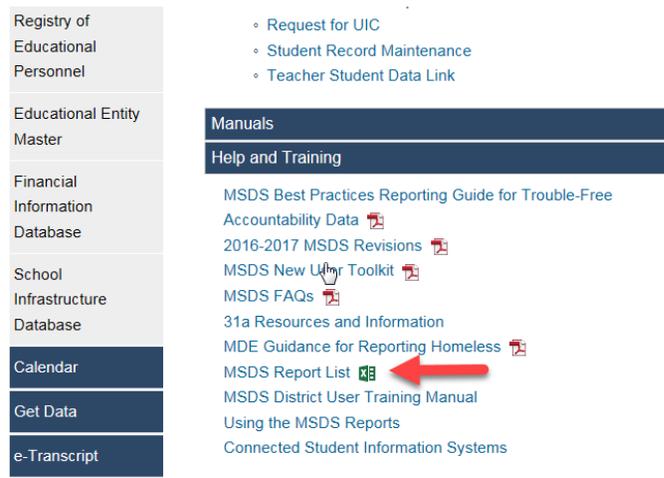
CEPI Helpful Hint: MSDS Report List

CEPI offers a detailed list of MSDS reports as a resource for users. This list is located on the CEPI home page under MSDS:

The Excel spreadsheet offers three separate “sheets,” which are:

1. **Report List** - provides a list of the names of the reports that CEPI has to offer, the report location, and the collection each report applies to.
2. **Report Details** - breaks down the report names and gives a description of each report. It also gives recommended/suggested uses for the reports. It will show which students will be included in each report.
3. **Version History** - shows the versions, dates and a description of the versions.
