## Released to the Public 2020-21 Data

- The <u>School Grades</u> report is based on the Michigan School Grades System in which schools receive up to five letter grades and three ranking labels for various school performance components.
- The English Learners Exited from English Learner Services metric, which shows the number of students exited from EL services in a given school year, has been updated on the English Learner Dashboard.
- Length of Time Receiving English Learner Services shows the median number of years students were enrolled in EL services before exiting. This metric has been updated on the <u>English Learner Dashboard</u> and the <u>Parent Dashboard</u>.
- The <u>Top 30/Bottom 30 Analysis</u> report shows information on students who score in the top 30%, middle 40% or bottom 30% on state tests. The data are broken out into multiple subgroups including race/ethnicity, gender, grade, and program participation, which identifies if a student is economically disadvantaged, an English learner, homeless, or disabled.

## Coming Soon 2020-21 Data

- Student-level data will be available for secure users only in the Summative Accountability and English Learner Accountability files located on the Accountability Downloads page.
- The <u>Annual Education Report</u> displays detailed information on student assessment, accountability, educator qualifications, National Assessment of Educational Progress, and Section 1003 School Improvement funds for schools, districts, and the state.

- The <u>Early Childhood Program Participation</u> report shows the number of children enrolled in select early childhood programs prior to kindergarten.
- The **Former English Learner Students** metric on the **English Learner Dashboard** shows a cumulative count of all students at a selected location who exited from EL services since 2011-12.
- The following metrics on the **Parent Dashboard** will be updated:
  - English Learner Participation shows whether at least 95% of English Learner students took the WIDA test.
  - English Learner Progress shows the percent of English Learner students making progress on the WIDA test.
  - Progress shows the percent of students demonstrating progress on the SAT, PSAT, M-STEP and MI-Access state tests.
  - Test Participation shows whether at least 95% of enrolled students took state tests in all subjects.
- Head Start, GSRP and GSRP/Head Start Blend providers with secure accounts
  can use the <u>Third Grade Assessment Outcomes for Early Childhood</u>
  <u>Participants</u> report to see how students previously enrolled in their
  programs performed on third grade M-STEP assessments. M-STEP
  performance is shown in the aggregate according to proficiency level, as well
  as at the student level.
