Released to the Public

- The <u>Compare Tool</u> has been updated with data from the most recent school year for all metrics. This tool allows users to compare up to 20 locations on a variety of topics.
- In 2019, Gov. Whitmer set a goal to increase the percentage of Michigan adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60% by the year 2030. In support of this initiative, the new <u>Postsecondary Attainment: Progress</u> <u>Toward Sixty by 30</u> Education Focus Area has been added to MI School Data. This report combines data from the Lumina Foundation, National Student Clearinghouse, and CEPI to explore postsecondary enrollment, persistence, and completion of Michigan students and track progress toward this goal.
- The <u>Success Rates</u> report has been updated with 2019-20 data. This report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. Successes include earning a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree at a public university or community college or transferring to a 4-year institution as a degree-seeking student from a community college. These rates capture both part- and fulltime enrollment, as well as mobility between institutions.

Released in Preview

• The target and performance data on indicators 1 to 14 of the Special Education <u>Annual Public Reporting</u> for the state, ISDs and districts have been released in preview, along with the Indicator data files with Part B and Part C information. During the preview period, logged-in users will see the updated report listed in the Special Education menu under the K-12 Grade dropdown as "New Annual Public Reporting (for secure users - preview only)." Data will be publicly available on May 28.
