### Released in Preview

 How have school districts rated the effectiveness of their teachers and administrators? The <u>Educator Effectiveness</u> report will be updated today with 2019-20 data in preview and will be publicly available in a week. Due to COVID-19, many educators were not evaluated for the 2019-20 school year.

#### Released to the Public

- The 2020-21 <u>Annual Education Report</u> will be publicly available tomorrow with detailed information on high school graduation, teacher quality, National Assessment of Educational Progress, and Section 1003 School Improvement funds for schools, districts, and the state. Due to COVID-19, the U.S. Department of Education waived many, but not all, of the required data elements for the 2020-21 AER. Please see the <u>2020-21 Updates</u> for an overview of changes for the AER. The <u>Directions to Access AER</u> document provides step-by-step instructions to access and download the report.
- COVID-19 continues to affect how districts provide instruction to their students. The <u>Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Dashboard</u> has been updated to include new data collected as of Wednesday, Dec. 9.
- The following **Parent Dashboard** items have been updated:
  - o **Teacher Retention** with 2018-19 data.
  - o **Teacher Years of Experience** with 2019-20 data.

## **Coming Soon**

- Data will be updated for the 2019-20 school year <u>Early Childhood Program Participation</u> report, which shows the number of children enrolled in Childcare Subsidy, *Early On®*, Early Childhood Special Education, Great Start Readiness Program, Head Start and GSRP/Head Start Blend prior to kindergarten.
- Attendance rates of K-3 students who participated in early childhood programs before entering kindergarten, such as GSRP, GSRP/Head Start Blend, Head Start, Early Head Start, Early Childhood Special Education or Early On® are shown in the K-3 Absenteeism and Early Childhood Participation report. This report will be updated with 2019-20 data.

The <u>college enrollment reports</u> for 2020 high school graduates will be delayed by one month. CEPI will begin publishing these reports in mid to late January 2021.
