## **Released in Preview**

• The Early Childhood Program Participation report, which shows the number of children enrolled in select early childhood programs prior to kindergarten, has been updated with 2019-20 data. Data are in preview and will be publicly available within a week.

## **Coming Soon**

- The <u>College Degrees and Certificates Awarded</u> report displaying student achievement at Michigan colleges and universities will be updated with 2019-20 data.
- Data showing the number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university will be updated in the <u>College Enrollment</u> <u>by High School</u> report for the 2018-19 school year and for fall 2020.
- <u>College Enrollment Destination</u> data showing the colleges and universities in which public high school students enrolled, by graduation year and school or district, will be updated with school year 2018-19 and fall 2020 data.
- Student progression in postsecondary education is shown in the <u>College</u> <u>Progression by Graduating Class</u> report. The report will be updated with data for high school graduation years 2018-19 and prior.
- The <u>College Remedial Coursework</u> report will be updated with 2018-19 data showing the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling in a Michigan college or university the year after high school graduation.
- Data for 2019-20 showing transfer patterns, demographics and performance data for students who transferred into or out of a Michigan college or university will be added to the <u>College Transfer</u> report.
- The <u>College Undergraduate Enrollment</u> report offers a closer look into the undergraduate classes of Michigan's colleges and universities, including the number of degree-seeking students, student age, and whether students

graduated from a Michigan public high school the year prior to enrollment. This report will be updated with 2019-20 data.

- Financial Information Reports and the Financial Transparency
   Dashboard will be updated with 2019-20 data. The dashboard gives users a comprehensive view of district finances and includes five-year trend information.
- The <u>On-Track College Progress</u> report shows the amount of time Michigan public high school graduates take to accumulate 24 college credits. This report will be updated with 2018-19 data.
- The <u>Pathways to Kindergarten</u> report contains data for publicly funded early childhood education taken by students before enrollment into kindergarten. Pathways to Kindergarten shows the order in which children enrolled in various programs, including developmental kindergarten. This report will be updated with 2020-21 data.
- Fall 2020 data will be added to the <u>Postsecondary Student Data File</u> for users with secure login access. This report shows student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and GPAs from in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.
- The <u>School-Level Expenditure Report</u>, which breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools, will be updated with 2019-20 data. Users can compare expenditures at the county, city, ISD, district or school levels with multiple visual tools.
- 2020-21 data will be added to the <u>Schools of Choice and Other Non-</u> <u>Resident Enrollments</u> report. This report displays counts and percentages of students enrolled in a school outside of the district they live in.
