Released to the Public

- The number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university within 6 months of high school graduation have been updated in the **College Enrollment by High School** report for fall 2020.
- <u>College Enrollment Destination</u> The colleges and universities in which public high school students enrolled 6 months after graduation, by graduation year and school or district, have been updated with fall 2020 data.
- The Early Childhood Program Participation by Kindergarten Class report shows the publicly funded early childhood education programs in which students were enrolled before entering kindergarten, such as Early On®, Early Childhood Special Education, Great Start Readiness Program, Head Start and GSRP/Head Start Blend. The report has been updated with 2020-21 data.
- COVID-19 continues to affect how districts provide instruction to their students. The <u>Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Dashboard</u> has been updated to include new data collected as of March 8.
- Data for 2020-21 have been added to the **Foundation Allowance** report, which shows the amount of revenue a selected public school district receives from the state per student enrolled.
- The <u>Parent Dashboard</u> has been updated with 2019-20 graduation and dropout rates.

Released in Preview

- The <u>College Undergraduate Enrollment</u> report offers a closer look at undergraduates at Michigan's colleges and universities, including the number of degree-seeking students, student age, and whether students graduated from a Michigan public high school the year prior to enrollment. The report has been updated with 2019-20 data and will be publicly available within a week.
- 2020-21 data have been added to the <u>Schools of Choice and Other Non-Resident Enrollments</u> report. This report displays counts and percentages of students enrolled in a school outside of the district where they live. Data will be publicly available within a week.

Released for Secure Users

• Fall 2020 data have been added to the **Postsecondary Student Data File** for users with secure login access. This report shows student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and GPAs for students from in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.

Coming Soon

- A new data file, the **Community College Demographic Enrollment Profile**, will be added to MI School Data on the Postsecondary Data Inventory page. Starting with 2019-20 data, the file will show the number of students enrolling in and receiving degrees at Michigan community colleges by age, gender and race/ethnicity.
- The following reports will be updated with 2019-20 postsecondary data for high school graduation years 2018-19 and prior:
 - The <u>College Enrollment by High School</u> report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university.
 - **<u>College Enrollment Destination</u>** data show the colleges and universities where public high school students enrolled.
 - Student progression in postsecondary education after high school graduation is shown in the <u>College Progression by Graduating</u> <u>Class</u> report.
 - The <u>College Remedial Coursework</u> shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling in a Michigan college or university the year after high school graduation.
 - The <u>On-Track College Progress</u> report shows the amount of time Michigan public high school graduates take to accumulate 24 college credits.

- The following **<u>Parent Dashboard</u>** metrics will be updated:
 - The **Postsecondary Completion Rate** and **Postsecondary Persistence Rate** metrics will be updated with 2019-20 data.
 - The **Ratio of Students to Instructional Staff** and **Ratio of Students to Support Staff** metrics will be updated with 2020-21 data.
