MI School Data Redesign Launch

The redesigned MI School Data website, which will be publicly released later this month, will include all the reports users are used to seeing, as well as exciting new features. MI School Data's updated look and feel are designed to connect users with the information they need quickly and easily. Specialized landing pages provide educators, parents, policymakers and members of the media with data of interest to them in one page. Education Focus Areas delve deeper into specific topics, displaying multiple types of data relevant to that topic and text descriptions to draw connections, provide context and highlight important information. The Education Map shows information about Michigan educational entities and regions, including fast facts, related locations and peer comparisons.

Recently Released to the Public

- In collaboration with the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity / Workforce Development, the following reports have been updated with 2020 data:
 - [**Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment**](#) shows annual wages for students one and five years after completing their highest level of education.
 - [**Entry Level Wages Over Time**](#) shows the trend of annual wages for students one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by level of education completed.
 - [**Median Annual Wages by Field of Study**](#) compares the annual wages of students who earned a postsecondary degree or certificate in a field of study one and five years after graduation. Comparisons can also be made between different fields of study.
 - [**Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment and High School CTE Status**](#) compares students' wages one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by high school CTE status and educational attainment.
 - [**High School CTE Status by Educational Attainment**](#) shows counts and percentages of highest level of education achieved, grouped by high school CTE status.

- [Award After Postsecondary CTE Completion](#) shows counts and percentages of postsecondary CTE completers who went on to earn postsecondary awards.
- [High School CTE Status of Postsecondary CTE Completers](#) shows the count and percentage of students receiving postsecondary CTE awards who participated in high school CTE.
- [Postsecondary CTE Awards by High School CTE Status](#) compares counts and percentages of high school graduates who earned a postsecondary CTE award, based on high school CTE participation.

Coming Soon

- Data showing attendance rates for all students, chronically absent students, and not chronically absent students for 2019-20 will be added to the [Student Attendance](#) report.
- School year 2019-20 data will be added to the [Student Mobility](#) report, which compares numbers of students transferring to, transferring from, and remaining in a district after fall count day.
- Data showing early intervention and special education services delivered to Michigan children during three important age spans – birth to third birthday, third birthday to kindergarten entry, and kindergarten to 3rd grade – have been updated in the Continuity of Service in Special Education reports with school year 2019-20 data.
 - The [Service Comparisons](#) report shows the percentage of students receiving services in each age group for a selected ISD compared to the statewide percentage.
 - The [Service Pathways](#) report shows the number and percentage of children receiving services in each age group, as well as when children began and finished receiving services.
