Recently Released with 2018-19 school year data

- The <u>Parent Dashboard</u> Student Attendance metric shows the average attendance rate of a selected school for each of the most recent 3 school years. Data are shown in comparison to the statewide attendance rate and the average attendance rate of similar schools based on location or student characteristics.
- The <u>Student Mobility</u> report shows the stability of a student population by comparing numbers of students transferring to, transferring from and remaining in a selected location over the course of a given school year.

Coming Soon

In collaboration with the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity — Workforce Development, the following Workforce reports will be updated with 2018-19 data, as well as additional report features.

Select reports now allow users to filter data by location or download data. Reports containing educational attainment status will now include data for "Students Continuing in Education and Students Unaccounted." An "Any CTE" column will show all students who participated in CTE compared to those with no CTE involvement.

- <u>Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment</u> shows annual wages for students one and five years after completing their highest level of education.
- <u>Median Annual Wages by Field of Study</u> compares the annual wages of students who earned a postsecondary degree or certificate in a field of study one and five years after graduation. Comparisons can also be

made between different fields of study.

- <u>Entry Level Wages Over Time</u> shows the trend of annual wages for students one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by level of education completed.
- <u>Postsecondary CTE Awards by High School CTE Status</u> compares counts and percentages of how many high school graduates earned a postsecondary CTE award, based on their high school CTE participation.
- <u>High School CTE Status of Postsecondary CTE Completers</u> shows the count and percentage of students receiving postsecondary CTE awards who participated in high school CTE.
- <u>Award After Postsecondary CTE Completion</u> shows counts and percentages of postsecondary CTE completers who went on to earn postsecondary awards.
- <u>Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment and High School CTE</u> <u>Status</u> compares students' wages one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped based on their high school CTE status and educational attainment.
- <u>Educational Attainment by High School CTE Status</u> shows counts and percentages of highest level of education achieved, grouped based on high school CTE status.
