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Introduction

Michigan is a national front-runner in calculating and reporting postsecondary success rates for its public institutions. Michigan's 15 public universities and 28 community colleges already self-report aggregate student data to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) collection for the U.S. Department of Education. IPEDS is a nationally recognized source for college graduation and completion data, but limits its measurement to first-time full-time students in its calculations. The Center for Educational Performance and Information (CEPI) began collecting student-level data starting with the 2009-10 enrollment class via the Student Transcript and Academic Record Repository (STARR) and the National Student Clearinghouse StudentTracker. In cooperation with the Michigan Association of State Universities, the Michigan Community College Association and participants from various public universities and community colleges across the state, CEPI worked to identify more consistent and reliable measures to calculate the state rates.

Postsecondary success rates show the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. These rates capture both part- and full-time enrollment as well as mobility between institutions. Achievement of a four-year degree from a university, a two-year degree from a community college or transfer to a university from a community college are all considered successes. The rates also contain a comprehensive success rate to showcase other successes such as earning a certificate, earning a bachelor's degree at a community college, or earning an associate's degree at a university.

Methodology

Each postsecondary success rates report provides data for a particular cohort year. The cohort year is the initial school year a student enters a Michigan public postsecondary institution, or when a high school student participating in an Early/Middle College program begins their fourth year of high school while enrolled at an institution of higher education. Cohorts for institutions are adjusted for students who transfer in and out of that institution.

For each cohort of students, outcomes are measured at the end of each year, beginning with year two for community colleges and year four for public universities.


- For community college cohorts, outcomes are reported at the end of the second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth rate year after initially entering the cohort.
- For public university cohorts, outcomes are reported at the end of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth year after initially entering the cohort.
- Student outcomes are categorized as Successes, Other Completers and Continuing. The diagram below provides a quick overview of the rate calculation process.

Fact Sheet



These success rates measure paths to success for postsecondary students without limiting the scope to solely two- or four-year degree attainment. Michigan measures successes for both full- and part-time students enrolled as degree-seeking.



To produce a more complete picture of student success, a comprehensive success rate is also calculated that tracks students who earn certificates, earn a bachelor's degree at a community college or earn an associate's degree at a university.



By accounting for mobility between institutions, these new success rates reported by CEPI give us a clearer picture of our college students' successes regardless of where they attend.



These data show that the traditional student path for obtaining a degree in two or four years is becoming less prevalent. When given an additional year or more, students are able to achieve more successful outcomes.



University success rates include full-time and part-time students who seek and attain a bachelor's degree. The method accounts for movement through and across institutions, thus accounting for mobility, and recognizing that the pace of movement through postsecondary is changing, with more students opting to attend part-time.



Statewide, four-year success rates for universities have increased with each cohort for the last three years. There is also a significant jump in successes when given a fifth or even a sixth year to complete a bachelor's degree.



Community college statewide two-year success rates have remained mostly level over the last five years. The significant number of part-time students enrolled in community colleges impacts the success rates in the first two years of enrollment. However, when given three or more years to achieve success, community college students are more likely to be successful.



When incorporating other successes like certificate completion and four-year degree attainment, community colleges' comprehensive success rates are significantly higher than their success rates.



When enrolling in an institution it is recognized that students have other postsecondary goals in mind beyond degree attainment such as certification exam preparation; while these successes are not currently measured in the rates, CEPI and the rate development workgroup will continue to explore methods of incorporating these other successes in the methodology.



Collecting the data and calculating it consistently will help ensure policy makers have a more accurate and complete picture of the success of all degree-seeking college students in Michigan public institutions.

2015 Community College Success Rates

As of 2015, it has been two years since the 2013 cohort (students who enrolled as degree-seeking students in 2013) enrolled; three years since the 2012 cohort enrolled, and so on. 
