**Framework Update – Laura Blastic**

1. We have delivered the primary delivery to transportation and we are working on creating shape files.
2. We are editing version 9 now and catching up on some projects that came in during lock down period.

## **Digital Ortho Update- Everett Root**

1. Genesee County to fly in spring 09. City of Flint is area of interest.
2. NAIP is back and funded on a 3yr cycle.
  - a. 1-meter cycle, 2 values min. partnership contribution and the full state partnership contribution.
  - b. 2010 flight, leaf on, 1 meter.
  - c. USGS will make a blanket contribution to the program.
3. MIP is evolving into different areas.
4. MIP is complete and time estimates are complete.
5. We have entered into partnerships with Ottawa and VanBuren.
6. Waiting on Bay City and Lapeer. Manistee is going to partner along with Cheboygan and Emmett.
7. Can select areas by Sept. 1 and then pullback if needed.
  - a. First access will be through the Internet.
  - a. Interactive website.
  - b. Search using vector data, road names, etc.
  - c. Status on ESRI contract?
  - d. Pulled off Ad board, we have since provided additional justification and will go back to the ad board.

## **MDNR Update**

1. Looking at a new project to integrate two track roads into framework for emergency management.
2. Working on pilot project with CGI. IFMAP used for their asset management.
3. Framework classification codes; all eight to have their own section.

## **MDOT Update – Joyce Newell**

1. We have converted version 8 into our caliber formats. Still waiting on ancillary layers.
2. Will try 2-3 Counties in house and see if we can subdivide out non federal aid roads.
3. 80k miles of road.
4. We are using photos and the MIP to outline subdivisions, etc.
5. If any Counties have already done this, if MDOT can get those results, please contact Joyce Newell.
6. If local agencies have traffic counts on the Non-Federal aid roads to share for the federal aid or non-federal aid roads, please contact Joyce Newell.

7. The system from 1982 is what has been used and we need to get a better handle on this.
8. Still discussing the pilot testing and any ideas would be welcome.

### **MSP Update – Eric Nischan**

1. Eric has accepted a position with the Federal Gov't.
2. Jacquelyn will take over until a new successor is in place.
3. We have a few student interns that are helping out.
4. Will post for the position after Eric is gone. Analyst 12 position.

### **CGI Updates- Everett Root**

1. NDH activity is underway and the last two groups of sub basins are being cleaned up.
2. CGI has been asked to assume responsibility for all shared services for the state.
  - a. Our office is taking on staff and additional responsibilities in order to enhance services.
  - b. We are taking on all Data Warehousing responsibilities.
  - c. We are taking on the ETL, data staging, extract transfer and loading components for the state.
  - d. We currently are working on a project with Treasury.
  - e. We are hoping to tie into the framework partnerships, etc. and integrate in a more formal way and increase input speed.
  - f. We are assuming responsibility as the Address Standardization, address service, master address file for the state and state programs.
  - g. We have added the Office of Technology Partnerships.
  - h. GIS will continue as well as mapping.

3. Working on Precinct Map for CGI, MSU continues to process imagery and updates for us.

#### **City of Lansing - Sam Quon**

1. Working on maintenance issues at this time.

### **Allegan County - Valdis Kalnins**

1. We are still making pdf tax maps; we are converting the html image map into a virtual earth map.
2. Have a court case for murder and it is geographically spread out and we have been asked to map out the area.
  - a. So we explored mapping in virtual earth.
  - b. Can link images, can tilt the imagery to look at different views. Could also create paths, etc.

### **Barry County - Rosemary Anger**

1. Trying to get 2008 parcel map update done.
2. Got a call from someone looking for police and fire locations. Referred them to the state.
3. Running for drain commissioner, one of 8 people running.

### **Kent County – Sharon Vanderbout**

1. Currently trying to pursue our LEPs in emergency management
  - a. Looking for a solution to fit all categories.
2. Core technologies for the sheriff dept, crime analysis application, the contractor has pushed to a google type interface and using the state framework to geocode and coming to Kent county and tapping into internal geocoding and into deeper layers and also looking at google geocoding service.
3. Network person remodeled the parcel data statistics.

### **KATS - Steve Stepek**

1. Working with South West region to update flight map. Process of gearing up long-range plan, model update.

### **SEMCOG – Ann Burns**

1. Processing version 8 and pulling out what is needed. It seems that all of the changes were included in version 8 from CGI.
2. We are standardizing how we name our files and folders for archiving older data.
3. Working with the Counties for the 2010 flight.
4. Our next SEMCOG meeting is next Tuesday.

### **USGS – Steve Aichele**

1. We are finishing up and collecting the initial deliveries for the data for the Detroit area.
2. Macomb, Oakland, Livingston and Wayne Counties were flown, along with ½ of Washtenaw and Monroe Counties.
3. Next year we are looking at 2009 footprints.
4. We are in talks with SEMCOG about a 2010 flight.
5. NRCS is now interested in collecting lidar in Wayne County.

1. Working on data that will be available soon on their website.

1. Partnering with state ducks unlimited.
