


The **Census Tracts** are outlined by the thick gray lines and labeled with black text.

The **Census Blocks** are outlined by the red lines and labeled with red text.
Example Block number would be **2038**

The standard viewing toolbar comes with these 3 functions:



The “—“ zooms out from the page.

The “100%” can be changed to any view percentage by entering a value.

The “+” zooms in to the page.

These maps are created at a page size of 34”x44” to allow enough space for labels to be readable. No information will be legible if the entire map is printed to an 8.5”x11” printer.

To print a portion of the map to an 8.5”x11” printer:

- 1.) Zoom to the area of interest
- 2.) Click on “File” in the upper left
- 3.) On the “File” pulldown menu Click “Print”
- 4.) On the “Print” menu, under the ‘Print Range’ area, click “Current View”
- 5.) Click “OK” to print
