**A. Framework Activities Update**

1. Deadline to submit changes for Version 11 is December 1; lockdown will be around February 1<sup>st</sup> with a delivery date in early April.

3. 2010 imagery went live on Bing Maps on September 1. Later in September, new imagery became available from the Digital Globe Clear 30 project. 900 1 degree by 1 degree tiles were delivered and 2 of these tiles were in MI and replaced the spring 2010 imagery. The Clear 30 imagery is leaf on, our standards are leaf off. MS is working on putting our tiles back.
