To make sure the water is healthy in school buildings, the water needs to be moved through the pipes and taps on a regular basis, especially before a building is re-opened after a long period of non-use. I would like to help you with water flushing. I could come into the school to help during system flushing or on a daily/weekly basis to go through to make sure every tap is flushed for 30 seconds to a minute. Just let me know how I can help.
