Parolable Lifers with Lifer Law Interview Parole Board Actions

The number of prisoners who have received life imprisonment sentences with the possibility of parole, who have also had lifer law interview parole board actions, and who have 10 years or more of elapsed time between the sentence date (adjusted for jail credits as necessary) and the end of calendar year 2015.¹

¹ A lifer law interview parole board action is an indication that the parole board has reviewed the case, but does not necessarily indicate that the prisoner has reached the point of eligibility for parole consideration, which would require a thorough file examination of the sentencing details for each individual case because of complexities such as the circumstances of the crime(s) committed, the sequencing of consecutive sentences, and applicability of potential sentence credits.
