

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to Public Act 252 of 2014
Article V, Section 816
Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the members of the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the state budget director, and the legislative corrections ombudsman with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October, 2014 to February, 2015 are \$1,605,885.04. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2014	\$294,991.97
November 2014	\$283,904.56
December 2014	\$374,440.06
January 2015	\$357,495.56
February 2015	\$295,052.89

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on February 25, 2015. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 13 times during the 2014-2015 Fiscal year. These occurred on March 26, 2014; July 30, 2014; August 27, 2014; September 17, 2014; September 24, 2014, October 10, 2014; October 29, 2014; November 5, 2014; November 19, 2014; December 17, 2014; January 28, 2015; February 18, 2015; February 25, 2015.
