

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to Public Act 84 of 2015
Article V, Section 816
Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the members of the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the state budget director, and the legislative corrections ombudsman with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2015 to February 2016 are \$1,430,266.44. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2015	\$342,021.53
November 2015	\$254,331.82
December 2015	\$286,453.11
January 2016	\$266,190.02
February 2016	\$281,269.96

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on March 16, 2016. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 17 times during the 2015-2016 Fiscal year. These occurred on January 28, 2015, February 18, 2015, February 25, 2015, March 25, 2015, April 22, 2015, May 27, 2015, June 19, 2015, July 22, 2015, August 11, 2015, September 23, 2015, November 4, 2015, November 18, 2015, December 16, 2015, January 20, 2016, January 27, 2016, February 16, 2016 and February 24, 2016.
