Get Away to the Great Wolf Lodge



MDOC employees are eligible for discounted rates on a one-night stay and four water park passes at Great Wolf Lodge in Traverse City.

Rates will be reduced to \$109 per room and resort fees will be reduced from \$29.99 to \$14.99. The offer includes a one-night stay in a room with two queen beds and a sofa sleeper, and four water park passes for adults or children ages four and older. There is no cost for water park passes for children three and younger.

The offer is valid only on Sunday, Sept. 29, 2019 and rooms must be booked by Aug. 29, 2019. Rooms at the discounted rate are limited.
