Glad you asked! There are several good reasons why everyone should participate in the Employee Survey.

Tell me more!

Ok, here they are:

- Commitment The State has invested time and effort into the survey and is committed to hearing from all of us in an open and inclusive manner. Did you know that only <u>half</u> of the organizations in the US survey their employees? I am glad the State is interested in investing in our opinions—that all opinions do matter here.
- 2) Change The survey captures and reports on all our responses. These responses tell our leadership what to focus on to change our culture if we don't share our views, then nothing will ever change. Aren't there areas where you really want to see some changes?
- 3) Ideas The survey allows us to share our voice, give ideas, and provide solutions in an anonymous way. Once the survey reports are made available to all of us, we can provide even more information through focus group sessions and the follow-up activities.
- 4) Recognition Remember that this survey is not only looking for opportunities for improvement, but will recognize what we are doing well. By participating in the survey, you can share how and where we have improved since the last survey. That's a good thing!
- 5) Pride It simply feels good to participate, to share your voice, anonymously, and to play a role in re-shaping our work environment. Knowing that your opinions can collectively change the State's culture and make this a great place to do great work is very powerful!


