

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**  
**Pursuant to Public Act 64 of 2019**  
**Section 816**  
**Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures**

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative corrections ombudsman, and the state budget office with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2019 to March 2020 are \$1,055,621.60. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2019	\$193,259.52
November 2019	\$178,322.66
December 2019	\$192,711.00
January 2020	\$188,434.31
February 2020	\$158,784.74
March 2020	\$144,109.37

Fiscal Year 2019 (October 2018-September 2019) antipsychotic medication expenditures totaled \$2,423,278.39

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on January 29, 2020. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 3 times during the 2019-2020 Fiscal year. These occurred on October 14, 2019, November 20, 2019 and January 29, 2020.
