

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to P.A. 245 of 2008 Section 403(6)
MPRI Parolees Tested Positive for Substances and Department Imposed Sanctions
September 2008 - February 2009

Section 403(6) of 2008 P.A. 245 requires that the Department of Corrections provide biannual reports on parolees who participated in the MPRI and have tested positive for substances in the previous 6 months. The report shall include any sanctions imposed by the department in response to the positive substance test.
