

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**  
**Pursuant to P.A. 268 of 2016**  
**Article V, Section 929**  
**Training Report for Staff with Youthful Offenders**

Section 929. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the department shall do all of the following: Ensure that any inmate care and control staff in contact with prisoners less than 18 years of age are adequately trained with regard to the developmental and mental health needs of prisoners less than 18 years of age. By April 1, the department shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget director on the training curriculum used and the number and types of staff receiving annual training under that curriculum.
