History of the House Street Disposal Area

- Wolverine Shoe & Tanning Co. purchases 1855 House Street NE in the early 1960's. Waste disposal predates purchase.
- Material disposed into trenches, storage ponds & seepage lagoons
- 1966: property licensed as an 1965 PA 87 solid waste disposal facility
- 1970: Waste disposal shifted to another location disposal area mothballed
- 1978: Solid waste disposal area license expires




Challenges of Sampling For PFAS

Drinking Water Sampling Results

38 Parcels have had their drinking water well sampled

- 10 parcels exceed a combination of PFOA & PFOS (>70 ng/L)
- 10 parcels have a moderate detection of PFAS (>10 ng/L)
- 6 parcels have low level PFAS (<10 ng/L)
- 9 parcels were non-detect for all PFAS
- 3 parcels are awaiting results

On-Site Investigation

- Soil borings and monitoring well installation ongoing according to the DEQ-approved conceptual work plan
- Groundwater sampling late September early October
- Preliminary findings to DEQ late November
- Additional steps will be based on the preliminary findings

Recommended Path Forward

- Continue sampling residential wells recommended by DEQ
- Offer bottled water and filters certified to remove PFAS to all residents within the area already tested or being tested
- Continue on-site investigation
