<a href="#">Brockway Mountain Wildlife Sanctuary</a> Eagle Harbor Township, MI Phone: (517)806-9144	- 7 miles east of Eagle Harbor - 394 acre wooded sanctuary of northern conifers and hardwoods - Small parking area along Brockway Mountain Dr. with a sign and a marked trail - Highest point along Brockway Ridge with spectacular views and abundant birdlife
