

SWP Program Goals


- Provide delineations for all Public Water Systems (PWS)
- Ensure that PWS incorporate source water protection
- Help PWS achieve “Substantial Implementation” with reasonable efforts



Substantial Implementation

- Municipal Systems must complete a full WHP program
- Non-municipal/NTNC – delineation and self assessment submitted to MDEQ
- Low tritium – sample < 1 TU and full program completion
- Must keep program/assessment updated to maintain SI

What can you do now?

- **Municipal Community Water Supplies**
 - Follow up to complete a Wellhead Protection Program
 - Update Program every 6 years
 - Apply for WHP Grants while funding is still available – June 15th deadline annually
 - Incorporate WHP as part of your O & M

NTNC and Private CWS

- Complete the self-assessment
 - Manage your property
 - Educate customers and nearby community
 - Contingency planning
 - Submit assessment to Wayne Kukuk:

Local Health Departments

- Use information in the sanitary survey and permitting process
- Encourage/assist in assessment completion
- Use for contamination investigation
- Submit assessments to Wayne Kukuk

- Inquire about WHP activities on visits
- Use WHP category information during surveys
- Refer communities to WHP staff
- Submit assessment to Wayne Kukuk
