

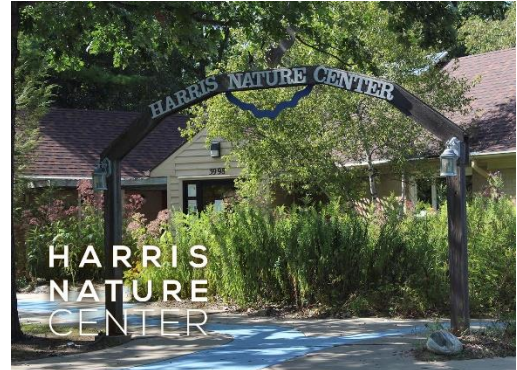

Harris Nature Center will be hosting a variety of fun Earth Day activities. Starting on April 19 at 8:30pm, we will be hosting guided dog-walking tours on our trails. Bringing flashlights and non-retractable leashes

is encouraged. \$3 per person, \$7 per family, please meet in the parking lot beforehand.

On April 27 there will be two events. First, we will need help keeping our trails healthy and safe by removing invasive plants, gardening, identifying and repairing troubled trail areas, and maintaining habitats. This is a volunteer opportunity that happens monthly, so feel free to join us again!

Secondly, there will be an Animal Babies Campfire, where you can sit by the campfire and learn about various animal babies while roasting marshmallows and taking a guided walk with a naturalist. \$3 per person, \$7 per family.
