Arbor Day at Rotary Park will involve planting, mulching, and weeding the park's trees.

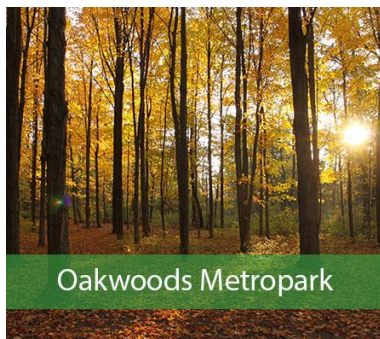
River Day will involve clean-up of locations along the Rouge River Watershed.
