**COLLABORATIVE STAKEHOLDER INITIATIVE (CSI) – REINVENTION OF STATE’S CLEANUP AND REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS.** Recently the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) embarked on a Collaborative Stakeholder Initiative (CSI) to reinvent the state’s cleanup and redevelopment programs. The DEQ selected the following seven areas on which to focus recommendations for improvement.

- Brownfield Redevelopment
- Groundwater Surface Water Interface
- Cleanup Criteria
- Part 201 Rules
- Due Care Obligations
- Vapor Intrusion
- Free Product/Source RemovalCsat

The DEQ partnered with stakeholders and Michigan State University (MSU), through its’ Cooperative Extension (MSUE) to design and implement this process. The CSI participants included DEQ staff and external practitioners with expertise and experience relevant to the issue. **WATER QUALITY MONITORING GRANT APPLICATION PACKAGE (GAP).** The Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ), Water Resources Division announces the availability of a GAP for water quality monitoring projects using fiscal year 2012 Clean Michigan Initiative-Clean Water Fund monies. Specifically, \$250,000 is available for water quality monitoring projects (non-beach) and \$200,000 is available for two-year inland beach monitoring grants. Local government and nonprofit entities are eligible for funding and are encouraged to apply either individually or as part of a group. The origin of the contamination is 880 Parsons Road, which is now the location of the Traverse Bay Area Career Technical Center (TBACTC). The proposed plan calls for in-place treatment of groundwater contaminated with chlorinated solvents on the TBACTC property by way an on-site Air Sparge System. The goal of this treatment is to prevent groundwater contaminated above generic residential cleanup criteria (promulgated under Part 201, Environmental Remediation, of Michigan's Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended) from leaving the TBACTC property and entering the Pine Grove Subdivision. During the time when the remedy is

being implemented, groundwater quality in the Pine Grove Subdivision area will be monitored to document the occurrence of natural attenuation of contaminants to a safe level below generic residential cleanup criteria. Land use restrictions are proposed on the TBACTC property to prevent activities that could result in unacceptable exposure to contamination and a resurgence of groundwater contamination. Contingency plans are included that will be implemented, if necessary, to assure the protectiveness of the response action.
