**COLLABORATIVE STAKEHOLDER INITIATIVE (CSI) – REINVENTION OF STATE’S CLEANUP AND REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS.** Recently the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) embarked on a Collaborative Stakeholder Initiative (CSI) to reinvent the state’s cleanup and redevelopment programs. The origin of the contamination is 880 Parsons Road, which is now the location of the Traverse Bay Area Career Technical Center (TBACTC). The proposed plan calls for in-place treatment of groundwater contaminated with chlorinated solvents on the TBACTC property by way an on-site Air Sparge System. The goal of this treatment is to prevent groundwater contaminated above generic residential cleanup criteria (promulgated under Part 201, Environmental Remediation, of Michigan's Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended) from leaving the TBACTC property and entering the Pine Grove Subdivision. During the time when the remedy is being implemented, groundwater quality in the Pine Grove Subdivision area will be monitored to document the occurrence of natural attenuation of contaminants to a safe level below generic residential cleanup criteria. Land use restrictions are proposed on the TBACTC property to prevent activities that could result in unacceptable exposure to contamination and a resurgence of groundwater contamination. Contingency plans are included that will be implemented, if necessary, to assure the protectiveness of the response action.
