**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Take notice that an evidentiary hearing will be held before the Supervisor of Wells (Supervisor) in the city of Lansing, Michigan, on the TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF MAY (MAY 21) 2018, BEGINNING AT 10:00 A.M., OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS MAY BE HEARD, OTTAWA BUILDING, SECOND FLOOR, 611 W. OTTAWA STREET, LANSING, MICHIGAN 48933. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Part 615, Supervisor of Wells, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), MCL 324.61501 *et seq.*; the administrative rules, 1996 AACRS, 2001 MR 2, 2002 MR 23, R 324.101 *et seq.*; and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; MSA 3.560(101) *et seq.*

The hearing is for the purpose of receiving testimony and evidence pertaining to the need or desirability of issuing an order in the matter of the petition of Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation (Petitioner).

The Petitioner seeks an order of the Supervisor statutorily pooling all interests into an established Special Order No. 1-86 and Order No. 6-7-90 drilling unit for the State Burleigh 1-26 HD2 well (Permit Number 49291), consisting of approximately 616.90 acres and described as:

Section 26: W 1/2  
Section 27: E 1/2  
Burleigh Township, Iosco County, T21N, R5E


You can obtain a copy of the written petition by requesting it in writing from Mr. Jerry L. Ritter, 2201 Kell Blvd., Wichita Falls, Texas 76308-1000, telephone number 940-716-5100.

Take note that if you wish to participate as a party in the hearing by presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses, you shall prepare and mail or otherwise deliver to the Petitioner and the Supervisor, not less than five days before the hearing date, an answer to the petition in the manner set forth in R 324.1204(6). Proof of mailing or delivering the answer shall be filed with the Supervisor on or before the date of the hearing. The answer shall state with specificity the interested person's position with regard to the petition. Failure to prepare and serve an answer in a timely manner shall preclude you from presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses at the hearing. If an answer to the petition is not filed, the Supervisor may elect to consider the petition and enter an order without oral hearing. Mail the answer to the petition to Mr. Jerry L. Ritter at the above address, and to the Supervisor in care of the Assistant Supervisor of Wells, Mr. Harold R. Fitch, Oil, Gas, and Minerals Division, P.O. Box 30256, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7756.

Take further note that you may request a change in the location of the hearing to the county in which the proposed drilling unit is located. An evidentiary hearing shall be held in the county in which the oil and gas rights are located if the majority of the owners of the oil and gas rights, which are listed in the petition as not voluntarily pooling their interests into the proposed drilling unit, file a written request to hold the hearing in that county with the Assistant Supervisor of Wells.
