The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Remediation and Redevelopment Division, has reviewed the No Further Action (NFA) Report submitted by Electrolux Home Products, Inc. on October 29, 2014. The NFA Report was submitted under Section 20114d of Part 201 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA). Based on this review, the NFA Report is approved.

The MDEQ has determined that the remedial action described in the NFA Report satisfies the requirement of Part 201 for the limited nonresidential and site-specific cleanup categories as provided for in Section 20120a(1)(d) and Section 20120a(2) of the NREPA. This correspondence serves as the No Further Action Letter as defined by Section 20101(1)(ee) of the NREPA.

The NFA Report required entry of a Post Closure Agreement pursuant to Section 20114d(3)(c) of the NREPA, to provide monitoring, operation and maintenance, and oversight necessary to assure the effectiveness and integrity of the remedial action. Enclosed please find a fully executed copy of the Post Closure Agreement entered between the MDEQ and Electrolux Home Products, Inc.

As provided in Section 20126(4)(e) of the NREPA, a person with an approved NFA Report has an exemption to liability for the environmental contamination addressed in the NFA Report, but may be subject to liability for environmental conditions under the circumstances described in that subparagraph.

Approval from the MDEQ is based upon representations and information contained in the NFA Report for the facility.

The MDEQ expresses no opinion as to other contaminants or areas beyond those identified and addressed as described in the NFA Report. The MDEQ makes no warranty as to the fitness of this facility for any general or specific use, and prospective purchasers or users are advised to use due diligence prior to acquiring any interest in or using this facility. The State reserves the right to take an action against Electrolux Home Products, Inc., if it discovers at any time that any material information provided by Electrolux Home Products, Inc. in the NFA Report was false or misleading.

All documents and data prepared, acquired, or relied upon in connection with this NFA Report must be maintained for not less than ten years after the date on which no further monitoring, operation, or maintenance is required pursuant to Section 20114d(7) of the NREPA, and shall be made available to the MDEQ upon request.
