Subject: Gelman - Periodic DEQ Update – Monitoring Well Installation

Pall Life Sciences (PLS) completed a boring last week on Park Lake Street just east of First Sister Lake. A previous monitoring well, MW-71, is located farther south on Park Lake. It appears from the results that this boring is at or near the highest concentrations of 1,4-dioxane along Park Lake in the Unit E plume.

The boring was vertically profiled at ten foot intervals where water was encountered. We do not yet have a boring log. Four samples from 19 to 60 feet below ground surface were all non-detect. Two samples from 89 to 100 feet were 138 and 61 parts per billion (ppb). Six samples from 109 to 180 feet were from 1,984 to 3,429 ppb, with the greatest concentration being deepest. One sample at 220 feet was 120 ppb. Bedrock was encountered at 226 feet.

PLS has installed two MWs in the areas of highest contamination, above and below a 20 foot thick clay layer. These are MW-108s and MW-108d.

We will be reviewing this information in more detail and discussing with PLS after we get the boring log and water level and water quality data from the permanent wells.

Additional monitoring well installation will continue after access is obtained, which is expected to be within two weeks.
