



A Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Policy and Procedure cannot establish regulatory requirements for parties outside of the DEQ. This document provides direction to DEQ staff regarding the implementation of rules and laws administered by the DEQ. It is merely explanatory; does not affect the rights of, or procedures and practices available to, the public; and does not have the force and effect of law.

ISSUE:

DEQ Policy and Procedures No. RRD-17, Time frame for DEQ review of Due Care Plan/Report submitted by SBA Loan Applicants, dated October 5, 2012 is rescinded. As of December 2012, statutory amendments to Parts 201 and 213 to sections 20114g and 21323n establish a timeframe of 45 days for the department to review all due care compliance documentation. The substance of Policy and Procedure No. RRD-17 is no longer necessary, and the 45 day review timeframe is no longer exclusive to SBA loan applicants.
